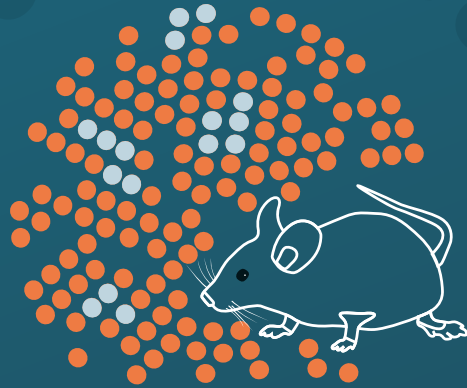


Animal Research Tomorrow

THE BASEL DECLARATION

The Basel Declaration is a call for more trust, transparency, and communication on animal research. The aim of the declaration is to bring the scientific community together to further advance the implementation of ethical principles such as the 3Rs whenever animals are being used, and to call for more trust, transparency, and communication on the sensitive topic of animals in research. The document was adopted on November 29, 2010, in Basel, Switzerland, at the conference «Research at a Crossroads».

The signatories, biomedical and animal welfare researchers, are committed to the 3R principle (Replace, Reduce, Refine), i.e., that animal experiments their area of expertise be planned and carried out with extreme care. In addition, they contribute to provide society with open and transparent information about animal experiments. Researchers who have signed the Basel Declaration hope that society, in return, will continue to recognise how essential animal experiments are for biomedical progress, now and in the future.
